TEACHER DIRECTIONS - FORM A

Teacher Says: Look at Sample A on page 1. Look at the different pictures. Which picture shows the person that is given credit for discovering America? Mark the circle under the correct picture.

Wait while students choose the answer.

Teacher Says: Which circle did you mark? Yes. That's right. You should have filled in the first circle under the picture of Christopher Columbus. Columbus is given credit for discovering America. Do you have any questions?

Teacher Says: Look at Sample B. In Sample B, which picture shows an animal that usually moves from place to place by hopping? Is it the lion, the walrus, or the kangaroo? Mark the circle under the correct picture.

Wait while students choose the answer.

Teacher Says: Which space did you choose? Yes. That's right. You should have filled in the circle under the kangaroo, because the kangaroo is the animal that usually moves from place to place by hopping. Do you have any questions?

Teacher Says: Now we will do some more problems like these. Look at the pictures in each row and listen carefully as I read each question. Then mark the circle under the correct picture.

Teacher Says: Look at number 1. When two people have a problem, what is the best way to solve it? Is it to talk about the problem, to run away from it, or to take a nap? Mark the circle under the correct picture.

Go to number 2. Look at the three pictures of food. Which picture shows a food that is good for you and will help you stay healthy? Is it the cake, the candy, or the apples? Mark the circle under the correct picture.

Move to number 3 on page 2. Look at the animal at the beginning of the row. Which animal in the row is most like it? Mark the circle under the correct picture.

Look at number 4. Find the picture that shows an object that a magnet would not pick up. Mark the circle under the correct picture.
