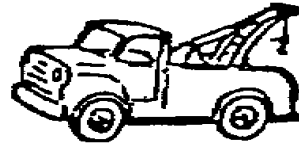
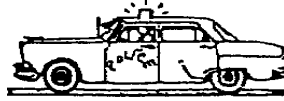
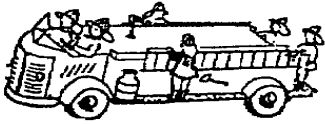


TEACHER SAYS: Move down to Number 2. Find the oldest method used for light.

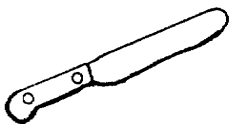
